A Macedonian court convicted a bear of theft and damage for stealing honey from a beekeeper who fought off the attacks with thumping 'turbo-folk' music. "I tried to distract the bear with lights and music because I heard bears are afraid of that," Zoran Kiseloski said after the year-long case of the bear v the beekeeper ended in the beekeeper's favour. "So I bought a generator, lit up the area and put on songs." The bear stayed away for a few weeks, but came back when the generator lost power. A court found the bear guilty, and since it had no owner and belonged to a protected species, ordered the state to pay \$3717 damages.

Organises insurance

- ABA insurance is provided for seven clubs and as an optional extra
- Personal beekeeping insurance is provided in 3 categories
 - 1- 20 hives or
 - 20 - 50 hives or
 - 50 – 100 hives

Insurance details

- Insurance is purchased in blocks in December each year.

- In 2008 blocks were purchased to cover:
 - 7 clubs

Individual beekeeping:

- 170 members -hives not exceeding 20
- 6 members - hives between 21 and 49
- 8 members - hives between 50 and 99

Are we covering our ABA Club insurance costs?

- ABA Club insurance
 - Premium \$3080
 - Capitation \$5535

Issue?

Note the tremendous loss of members. A club of 57 members loses 33 and gains 8!

The ABA overall is 45 members down on last year.

This does not bode well for the future!

Suggestions were made about “open” days, advertising, promotion of beekeeping as a hobby, more work with schools etc.

Coordinates the Swarm hotline

The swarm hotline was introduced to centralise swarm collection.

- It has establishment costs but was initially very successful
- It is operated on the good will of a non ABA member.

There is widespread discontentment with this “service”. Many clubs have their own swarm patrol system in place.

The system now runs at a loss. Should it be a non profit web based system? Can the existing system be made to work more effectively?

Kenneth R. Parry who died a short time ago at the age of 88 was one of the last links with the Late Colonel Guy Pulling, the founder of our Organisation, The Amateur Beekeepers' Association of N.S.W. Inc.

Ken who was made a life member of the Association in 1984 used to attend Col. Pulling's talks and demonstrations at his apiary at Turrumurra before transferring to the Illawarra Branch in 1961.

Over the years Ken Parry served as President and General Secretary of the A.B.A. of N.S.W. After joining the Illawarra Branch, Ken was elected Branch President from 1965 to 1975. He was also responsible for the Branch Apiary and Chief Instructor for over 10 years. He also represented the interests of the Illawarra Branch Members as an A.B.A. Councillor from 1966 to 1991 and beyond. His presence and wise counsel will be sadly missed.
